The Rules

General Kata Rules

- Competitors must meet the AGE and GRADE criteria for each category no trading up!
- Competitors will wear either a red (aka) or blue (ao) belt
- Competitors will compete at the same time until the final where they will perform individually
- Judges will use the flag system in all rounds including the final
- Judging criteria will follow the WKF principles of Conformance, Athletic Performance and Technical Performance
- There will be two bronze medals awarded in each category.
- Repecharge will apply only in Brown and Black Belt events!
- 7th Kyu 4th Kyu competitors must have a minimum of 2 katas and alternate by round. Brown
 & Black belt competitors must perform a different kata in each round.
- Teams will perform one team at a time and may repeat any kata.
- Only the standard 26 Shotokan kata are allowed. No Junro or Koten kata.

General Kumite Rules

- Standard WKF Rules will apply (https://www.wkf.net/pdf/WKFCompetitionRules2018.pdf) unless highlighted below.
- All bouts will be one and a half minutes. Atoshi Baraku will be 15 seconds.
- Protective Equipment for Kumite (Compulsory unless stated)
 - o Red and Blue Mitts (same colour as the belt)
 - Red and Blue Shin and Instep Protectors (14yrs and over)
 - o Gum Shield
 - Groin Guard (male competitors)
 - Chest Protector (female 14yrs and over)
 - o Red or Blue Shin and Instep Protectors are optional for 13 years and under

Contact in Kumite

- 8 years to 13 years no contact to the head or face with hands or feet
- 14 to 17 years no head or face contact with the hands, light non-injurious contact with the feet
- 18 years and over non-injurious contact to the head and face is allowed with hands and feet

Team Kumite

- Teams will consist of three fighters and up to two substitutes
- Teams must submit a fighting order at the start of each round, failure to do so or not fighting to that order will result in disqualification.
- Fighting orders may be changed between rounds, but not once the round has started
- The winner will be the team with the most bout victories, if tied the winner will be the team with the most points scored in both winning and losing bouts.
- Victory by disqualification or Kiken will count as 8-o when calculating scores



Coaches / Appeals

- Only coaches and competitors will be allowed inside the competition area. Coaches must have a valid coaches pass.
- Coach passes will be supplied according to the number of entries per club
- Coaches are not allowed in kata competition, kumite competitors may have ONLY ONE coach at any particular time
- Coaches must wear a tracksuit and training shoes coaching in a gi (or part of a gi) is not permitted
- Coaches / competitors should not approach Referees or Judges to discuss decisions. All appeals must be made in writing to the Chief Referee. A deposit of £50 will be required to lodge an appeal; if successful the £50 will be refunded.
- Appeals will only be upheld in cases where it is clear that there has been a mis-interpretation of
 the rules or in the operating procedures of the competition. Appeals relating to the decision of
 referees or judges will not be entertained.

Completing the Entry Form / Age and Grades

• Please enter the competitor as the grade and age they will be on the day of competing. i.e. if they have a grading or birthday in-between, this needs to be taken into consideration when filling in the form.

Age/grade can and will be inspected randomly on the request of officials and coaches, it is your responsibility to have your association license with you for verification. In the event of a dispute of age or grade the inability to provide evidence shall result in disqualification with no recompense.
